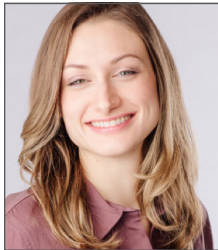


GRANT MUNRO, *BSc'01 (First term ending 2023)*
