Information about how to browse journal articles for UBC Alumni.

There are two distinct and separate places to browse journals from home. Both of these options are only available to credit degree and diploma holders of the University of British Columbia (ie: UBC Alumni). One is from the *alumni UBC* website for journals provided by *alumni UBC* (requires name and date of birth to login). The other is through the UBC Library website for journals provided by the UBC Library (requires a CWL to login). These two different options are detailed below.

Neither of these logins require an Alumni Card barcode (that was an old requirement that has been removed). If you access the journals directly from your new *alumni UBC* app, you are searching through the journals that are provided by *alumni UBC* and not the ones provided by the UBC Library.

Both of these options for browsing journals from home are limited in their scope due to copyright requirements. If you need to access the full suite of academic material available to UBC you can do that from a physical branch of the UBC Library.



Requires you sign in with your name and date of birth. All alumni are pre-registered and just need to use their information to login. If you are having any trouble with login you should contact the alumni front desk at alumni.ubc@ubc.ca






6) Now you are at the basic search function where you can put in any search terms you want to look for. There is no need to 'sign in' as you are already authenticated and can search directly from the search bar

Ex: you could put 'Healthy Living' in the search bar and you will find journal articles related to healthy living

- 7) Click search to find a list of journal articles related to your topic
- 8) Browse the search results and click PDF Full Text if you want to read the full journal article
- 9) Click New Search if you want to come back to the search bar
- 10) Advanced Search
 - a. If you are interested in a more detailed search option click advanced search. This is the way that you could browse articles from one specific journal.
 - b. Ex: if you want to look for articles from Scientific American. Add this term to the search hox
 - c. Ex: then you would select from search type that you are looking specifically at a Journal
 - d. Ex: then search. This will show all articles that are from Scientific American.

 - 3. Login with your CWL

 - 6. Select PDF to view the full text of the journal article you are interested in reading


